
Once upon a time, in the beautiful city of Halifax, Nova Scotia, emerged a band that would grace the stages with the richness of soulful blues. Garnetta Cromwell & DaGroovmasters are not just a band, but a delightful musical tale that weaves through time.

Garnetta Cromwell, the magnetic lead vocalist, embarked on her musical journey as a young girl in Montreal. Being the youngest of eight siblings, she was raised in an Afro-Metis household, where music became her solace. Despite facing a hearing impairment in her childhood that required surgical treatment, Garnetta's passion for music remained unwavering. She found inspiration in gospel, blues, country, and soul music, and started performing at talent contests. Her music also served as a tribute to her mother, Marva Ann Fairfax, who used music to survive and thrive. Garnetta later became the lead vocalist and drummer for Toronto's only female reggae band, Sweet Sensation. In 2021, after facing numerous personal challenges, she decided to take full-time control of her band, Garnetta Cromwell & DaGroovmasters, determined to create music that reflected her life's journey.

The band itself, DaGroovmasters, is composed of talented musicians specializing in soulful blues. Among them is Mark Howe, also known as "DaFunkmaster," who plays the bass. Mark, an extraordinary bassist, has mastered the groove across genres but specializes in Funk, Soul, and Blues. He played with The Jeff Healey Band in the mid-80s and led his own band, Spectrum, until 2020 when he became a full-time bassist for Garnetta Cromwell & DaGroovmasters.

Another gem in the band is Toshihiro Otani, the lead guitarist known as "TOSHI." Born and raised in Japan, Toshi taught himself to play guitar at the age of 12. He was part of Tokyo's vibrant Chicago-style blues scene before moving to Canada in 2013.

Garnetta Cromwell & DaGroovmasters is a classic soulful blues band that delivers highenergy performances. They have performed at various events, including the 24th Annual Southside Shuffle in September 2022, one of Canada's best-known blues festivals. The band's upbeat music brings pure joy to the audience, as they continue to spread their soulful and funky fusion blues sound through live performances. Their first Blues single,

"Miss Marva Ann," was released in January 2022. As of May 2023, they are recording their first full album with Ken Whiteley as their producer, titled *Time to Shine*, which is scheduled to be released in the fall of 2023.

The narrative of Garnetta Cromwell & DaGroovmasters is one of resilience, passion, and the transformative power of music. Garnetta's story is particularly inspiring, as she navigated through the adversities of life, using music as her guiding light. The band's soulful blues is not just music, but a reflection of the experiences and emotions that shape our lives. They've garnered respect in the blues community, winning the Toronto Blues Society's Talent Search in July 2022 and earning a spot to compete in the International Blues Challenge in Memphis, Tennessee in January 2023.

20 Years of Grand River Blues

The Toronto Blues Society has just completed a strategic planning process where board members and members of the Musicians Advisory Committee have been getting together to discuss the organization's identity and help shape the path forward. It seems like a good time to look at how other blues societies operate and in this issue, Grand River Blues Society founder and president Bruce Hall talks about what they've been doing. We hope in future editions we can tell the stories of all the great blues societies who are keeping the blues alive in Canada.



The Grand River Blues Society and its dedicated volunteer board of directors are committed to the enhancement of Blues music in its varied

and diverse forms for the past 20 years.

The GRBS was founded 2003 to serve the Grand River region of south-central Ontario, encompassing the cities of Kitchener, Waterloo, Guelph, Cambridge, Brantford, and surrounding areas. The last few years, we have also been expanding into the Hamilton Escarpment region. The Society is dedicated to the preservation of Traditional Blues music and the advancement of this unique art form of international appeal.

The Grand River Blues Society is committed to supporting and promoting the Blues music culture and heritage through the following:

We provide fundraising and support for local and regional artists, wishing to participate in the International Blues Challenge in Memphis.

We have recorded and distributed the music of local and regional artists, to increase their exposure outside the Grand River Region.

We showcase local, regional, and international artists at special events, tributes, fundraisers, and festivals.

The GRBS has successfully produced an annual Youth Legacy Competition in partnership with The Kitchener Blues Community Inc. This aids to inspire young musicians, under the age of twenty-one, with the winner having the opportunity to perform at the TD Kitchener Blues festival.

We organize and run an annual Blues Camp, for musicians up to 19 years of age, supported by the teaching and nurturing of our local professional musicians.



Each August The Grand River Blues Camp (Kitchener Blues Festival) offers a four-day **Youth Blues Camp**, providing an intensive Blues educational experience to improve musical skills, to learn from and play with professional musicians. On the last day of the Camp students perform with peers at the Kitchener Blues Festival (this year it's on Friday August 11th). For many students, teachers and fans, the Blues Camp is one of the highlights of their musical year. We partner with the Kitchener Blues Community Inc., in an annual "Blues in the Schools" program, specifically geared to grade school students. We have another round of presentations commencing autumn 2023.

We communicate the ongoing events and artist information to Society members and the public, by means of our website and social media. In addition, we distribute a bi-monthly newsletter via email.

Our weekly e-mail we call the "Blues Buzz" not only reaches our membership but can also be seen on our Facebook page, Twitter feed, and our website. The Blues Buzz now reaches over 750 subscribers.

We work in conjunction with Blues club owners and other businesses to support Blues music and musicians by assisting in marketing them and selling their CDs and T-Shirts at events.We are dedicated to encouraging Blues lovers to enjoy the benefits of Society membership and to actively participate in attaining our goals, through support for events and volunteering. We conduct and support artist tribute shows, workshops, and fundraisers of historical significance, to better inform our members and the public, of the Blues' legacy.

We are very proud of what we have accomplished. The GRBS is recognized as one of the hottest Blues Scenes in Canada.

We would like to recognize our loyal Members, our Blues Fans, all our wonderful Volunteers, and the dedicated Board of Directors who for 20 years have continued to provide exceptional events.

We have already presented for 2023, The Weber Brothers with opening act Felicia McMinn of Port Dover to a Sold - Out Show at the Polish Hall in Brantford on March 4th. We followed that with our first Grand Thursday at the Polish Hall on April 6th with Steve Marriner, Blake Manning, Jesse O'Brien, and Jimmy Bowskill. Sunday April 30th Glenn Marais and the Mojo Train competed in Hamilton with 6 other bands and became our IBC Memphis band for 2024. May 7th the GRBS partnered with the TDKBF to select The Trainwrecks (a youth band whom all have attended our youth camp) to become the Legacy Band to appear on the big stage in August at the Kitchener Blues Festival. Members of the GRBS attended a free show presented to celebrate our 20th Anniversary for Ben Rollo's Music of Tom Petty and the Heartbreakers on May 18th at the Polish Hall in Brantford. June 11th our Road to Memphis was held at The Front Porch & Southern Kitchen in Langton and Patrick Fockler earned the right over 7 other solo acts to attend the IBC in Memphis in 2024.

Thank you for helping us celebrate and we hope to see you during the rest of the year celebrating our 20th Anniversary at events and presentations.

Congratulations Patrick Fockler from Newmarket who will be the Grand River Blues Society's solo representative at the 2024 International Blues Challenge in Memphis. The Glenn Marais Band was previously selected in the band competition. A sold out crowd came out to The Front Porch & Southern Kitchen in Langton for the solo showdown.

Awards and Recognition: Raven Kanatakta and ShoShona Kish of Digging Roots were awarded the 2023 CMW Allan Slaight Humanitarian Spirit Award in recognition of their longstanding commitment to charitable initiatives. They accepted the honour during a special presentation at the Westin Harbour Castle hotel, on Toronto's Waterfront, on June 10, 2023. The CMW Allan Slaight Humanitarian Award is presented annually to a Canadian artist, duo, or group, in recognition of their social activism and benevolent support of humanitarian interests and causes. As recipient of this Award, The Slaight Family Foundation will make a sizable donation



towards Digging Roots's chosen cause, to acquire and donate ground-penetrating radar machines that will allow First Nation communities to survey and find children murdered in their traditional territories when mandated Residential Schools operated across Canada. Says Raven, "We're in a time of reconciliation, we need to move our allied discussions from conversation to action, and that means we need co-conspirators to get the healing process started. It's time to learn from the past so we don't repeat the injustices of yesteryear. The only way forward is to face the truth of this country and implement solutions for peace."

Dawn Tyler Watson inducted into the London Music Hall of Fame during the Forest City London Music Awards on June 18. Dawn Tyler Watson moved to London from England as a child and competed at local Kiwanis festivals and attended Catholic Central High. She struggled at times, including living on the streets, and worked at various nightclubs before moving to Montreal's Concordia University to study theatre and jazz. "The blues chose me," she said, "We all have a path... You need to be true to yourself and always love what you do."

Other nominees are Russell Jackson for Bass Guitarist Of The Year, Kenny "Blues Boss" Wayne for Keyboard Player Of The Year, Sass Jordan - Bitches Blues for Rock Blues Album and Angelique Francis -Ashamed for Blues Video Of The Year. Kitchener Blues

The 2023 Kitchener Blues Festival in Ontario is set to be an unforgettable four-day immersive musical experience. The festival returns this year with a lineup of impressive blues artists as well as a few big attractions who might not be considered blues including The Spin Doctors, an American alternative rock band from New York City best known for their early 1990s hits "Two Princes" and "Little Miss Can't Be Wrong". They do have a blues connection in that their guitarist, Eric Schenkman, has a residency at the Toronto blues destination, Grossman's Tavern. Other headliners include Downchild, Digging Roots, MonkeyJunk, Samantha Martin and Delta Sugar, Canadian guitarslingers Steve Strongman, Justin Saladino, Frank Cosentino, Spencer Mackenzie, Sean Pinchin and David Gogo, festival favourite Dawn Tyler Watson, local heroes Miss Angel & The Homewreckers and American blues stars Samantha Fish, Mr. Sipp and Albert Cummings. The Trainwrecks, winners of this year's Youth Legacy Showcase will also perform. There's a slew of workshops and special tributes to Jeff Beck, Mendelson Joe and Ronnie Hawkins.

The festival is conveniently located in downtown Kitchener, a vibrant area brimming with city gems and numerous dining and shopping options. Attendees are encouraged to explore downtown Kitchener before the festival begins for a well-rounded experience of the city. For those coming from out of town, the official hotel of the Kitchener Blues Festival, Crowne Plaza, offers a convenient and comfortable stay. Situated in the heart of downtown Kitchener, it is just steps away from the festival and many local amenities.

It's a free festival except for the Thursday night fundraising concert with Digging Roots and the Spin Doctors. Blues Patrons can get the gold/VIP ticket for \$175 (\$40 for us regular blues fans). Attendees are also given the opportunity to contribute to the festival's success and sustainability by donating at one of the donation stations. Please support this treasure on the Canadian blues landscape.

The festival organizers have taken measures to ensure that the event is accessible to everyone. Anyone requiring accessibility accommodations is encouraged to contact the festival through their website or at info@kitchenerbluesfestival.com. When it comes to seating at the festival, it is available on a first-come, first-served basis, with designated areas for portable folding chairs at each of the three major stage locations. This allows attendees to enjoy the performances in comfort.

For those cycling to the festival, a new Bikecheck service is being introduced. This

service allows attendees to hand their bikes to an attendant and enjoy the event without worrying about their bikes' safety. The Bikecheck location is situated in Victoria Park, close to the Clocktower.


